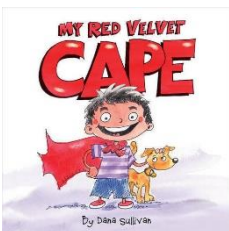
Michael Razi (5:15)

Frank, a spider who loves to weave amazing artistic webs, wakes up one day to discover he's missing a leg. Is he still a spider if he only has seven legs?



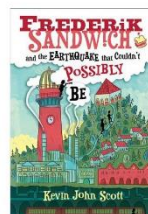
A.L. Collins (5:45)
